

Branch 13 Information Sheet

Operating Assumptions

- The location has been decided near 210th and Q Streets. A contract is currently in negotiation between the City of Omaha and Millard Public Schools for the site.
- Branch 13 will be the 4th Omaha Public Library branch west of 90th Street in Douglas County.
- Omaha Public Library has no plans to close any current location when Branch 13 opens to the public.

Population Growth 1999 to 2019

- Douglas County added 120,603 residents between 1999 and 2019 to increase the population from 446,277 to 566,880. The population has grown 22% in 20 years.
- The original Millard Branch opened in 1981 to accommodate a service population of 35,000. The branch was expanded in 1999 to serve a population of 70,000. Millard Branch is currently serving a population of 164,000. As a comparison, Bess Johnson Elkhorn Branch has a service population of 33,000 and Saddlebrook Branch has a service population of 40,000.

Branch 13 Service Area

- Branch 13's service area is defined by the 6 Douglas County zip codes roughly located near 156th Street as the eastern boundary, the east side of the county line as the western boundary, Maple Street as the northern boundary, and the north side of Harrison Street as the southern boundary.
