(hold up five fingers)

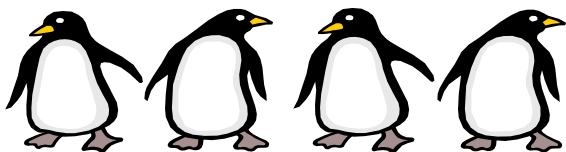


I Know a Little Penguin

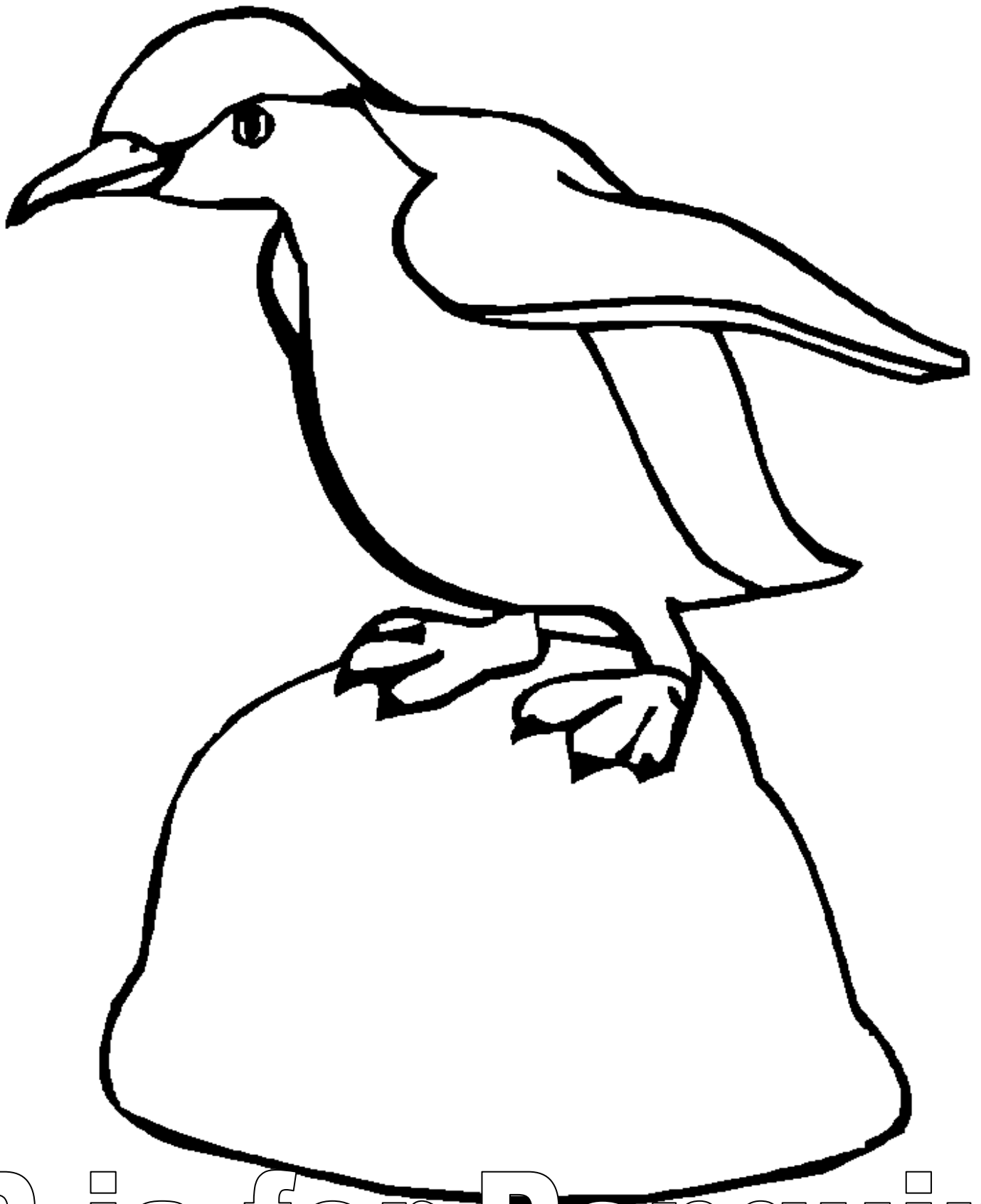
